Eligibility: High School students & adults. Open to the public.

Fee & Deadline for Entry: No Fee. Entry forms and artwork photos as **jpgs** must be received by, **END OF BUSINESS DAY, AUGUST 10, 2018.**

Show Type: Juried artwork. Award winning artist will judge.

Competition: Ribbons awarded for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, place, Best of Show, Honorable Mention and People's Choice Award.

Art Drop-off: Fri., Aug. 24, 2018, 2:30pm to 6:00 PM

Art Pick-up: Sat., Aug. 25, 2018, 5:15 PM after the show

Drop-off at the Elk Grove Regional Park Pavilion, 9950 Elk Grove-Florin Road, Elk Grove, CA. Be sure to label your work and prepare a display card for your pieces with your name and address, title, price and include the same with your jpeg. Artist's Statement ([download template here](#)).

Art not picked up will be set aside for donation fund raising purposes. Art not selected for the Show: You will be notified immediately.

Limit: Up to Four (4) entries. Artists are asked to send a written, "one paragraph bio/statement" with their entry to post next to

their art work at the show. Visit elkgrovecity.org/mcfArtShow for downloadable statement.

Eligible Art: All work should be original, conceived and created solely by the entering artist. No Gouache, Giclee or airbrush. Art previously entered in a Multicultural Art Show and Competition will not be accepted.

Sales: Must be made directly with artist after the show. The buyer's contact information will be given to the artist.

Framing: Frames must be in good condition and paintings must be wired for hanging—no saw tooth hangers. If unframed, the sides must be finished—no staples or ragged edges.

NO EXCEPTIONS.

Size limitations: Works may be no larger than 36" x 40" on any one side. Three-dimensional pieces are subject to approval. Please list the size of your art including the frame. Indicate the width and length size of each piece of art.

Security/Liability: All reasonable care will be taken in handling artwork, however our officers and volunteers will not be responsible for loss or damage to paintings or other artwork. We do suggest you carry separate insurance on your artwork.
